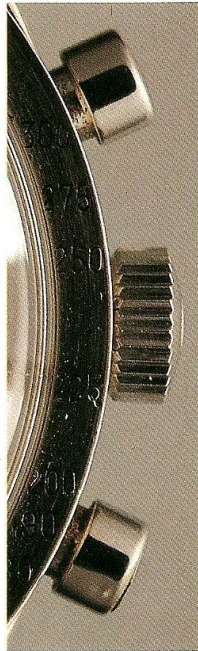


Changes in Push Buttons



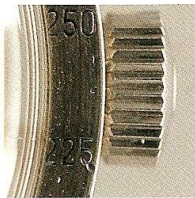
4mm Diameter
CK2915-CK2998 (1957-1962)



5mm Diameter
ST105003- (1962-)

Omega used a 4mm diameter push button up until the second model, the same push button it was already using in the Seamaster chronograph. The addition of an O-ring for greater ease of use resulted in the increase in diameter.

Changes in Winding Crowns



6mm Diameter
CK2915 (1957-59)



7mm Diameter
CK2998-ST105012 (1959-1967)



6.5mm Diameter
ST145012- (1966-)

Omega started by using the same small-diameter winding crown as in the Seamaster chronograph, but here, too, the addition of an O-ring resulted in an increased diameter to 7mm. Later, Omega installed a guard integral with the case, which reduced the diameter slightly, to 6.5mm.
